 NATURAL GAS SPURS ALABAMA'S GROWTH



Natural gas supports Alabama's **aerospace and aviation, agricultural, automotive, and forestry** industries.



Residential natural gas costs have **DECREASED BY 14%** since 2006.



Costs for manufacturing and commercial users have **DECREASED BY 25%** since 2006.

40% of Alabama electricity is generated with **natural gas.**



Energy-related CO₂ emissions **DECREASED BY 22%** from 2005-2018 as natural gas became the largest power generation source.



From 1996 to 2018, carbon dioxide emissions from Alabama's industrial sector **DECREASED by 30%.**

A ban on Alabama's federal oil and gas leasing would have potentially devastating impacts on the state.¹

IN 2030

over **7,000** jobs and **\$637 million** in GDP

IN 2040
